COVID Report:

LA County is now at a low-risk status. Although our risk is low it is good to remember that Covid-19 claimed the lives of 97 people in LA County last week and we all should be taking precautions to keep each other safe.

In the Acton and Agua-Dulce surrounding areas, there have been 7 new cases this past week. In our AADUSD school community, we have had 8 positive cases last week and exposure notifications have been sent for those exposures.

Employees got the good news on Monday that the requirement to test if not vaccinated had been rescinded. We do however encourage all our staff,

vaccinated or not, to test if they have symptoms, no matter how mild, in order to keep our community safe. Every school site has covid-19 testing kits for students and staff who asks for one. Our Enhanced Health Clinics have started again. Tuesday was our 3rd clinic and our next one occurs on October 4th from 2-4 pm at the district office MPR.

They offer the new Covid-19 booster for adults, Covid-19 child booster, 1st, and 2nd Covid-19 shots, Tdap, & HPV vaccines, and information on various social safety net programs and other health issues.
