To Parents, Guardians and Staff,

As you are aware, Meadowlark Elementary School will be a voting center for the upcoming "Primary Presidential Election". The dates designated for Meadowlark to be used will be February 29<sup>th</sup>, March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and ending on the 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Site and district staff has developed a plan to ensure the safety of students on these days.

- All students will be having lunch outdoors. Additional picnic benches will be placed to accommodate the students and staff. This designated area will have additional supervision to once again ensure the safety of our students. In the case of inclement weather we will have students eat lunch in classrooms and library, additional personnel will be available to assist with students.
- Staff will strictly monitor the students entering and exiting the MPR to pick up their lunches.
- Poll workers and voter entrance will only be accessible at the side door of the MPR. There will be no need for voters or poll workers to access the office or any area beyond the MPR.
- There will be no parking for voters or poll workers in the parking lot.
- Additional safety personnel will be stationed in areas to assist voters with direction and to ensure that the campus is secure.
- Portable restrooms have been requisitioned and will be available for poll workers and voters to use. **STUDENT RESTROOMS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE FOR POLL WORKERS OR VOTERS.**
