Flu Shot Clinic

Wednesday, October 30, 1 - 5 pm

Flu vaccines are recommended for everyone 6 months of age and older. It's especially important to get a flu shot if you are 6 mo - 18 yrs old, 50 yrs or older, pregnant or just had a baby, morbidly obese, a healthcare provider, living in a nursing or other long-term care home, living with a weakened immune system or a chronic medical condition like diabetes, heart disease, or lung disease, or living with or caring for someone under age 5, over age 50, or with a chronic medical condition. If you have a severe egg allergy or are sick the day of the clinic, check with your doctor before getting vaccinated. Call your regular health care provider to see what other shots you may need. If you don't have a regular provider, call 2-1-1 (LA County Information Line) or visit publichealth.lacounty.gov/ip for a list of no cost or low-cost vaccine providers.
